## Be a Home and Hope Booster

Twice a year the UUSJ Task Force on Economic Justice and Homelessness asks Chicago area U.U. congregations to nominate such an organization that their congregation is helping with significant financial and/or volunteer support. Congregations may also nominate themselves, if they are providing direct services to the homeless and have unreimbursed expenses.

The members of the task force select the winning nominee, giving preference to nominees who have not received a grant previously. When there are multiple nominees who have received a Home and Hope Booster grant before, the amount of volunteer and financial support given by the nominating U.U. congregation has great weight in which nominee is selected.

The pledgers are then provided the details of the winning nomination via ground mail and asked to send in their pledge amount in the return envelope within the next 30 days. The amounts given are then consolidated into a Home and Hope Booster grant which is sent to the designated organization.
